



Technology Committee

The BPS Technology Committee provides appropriate oversight of institutional technology, ensuring that Bridges Prep develops and reviews, at minimum, a 2-5-year technology plan that positively impacts student achievement by supporting the BPS mission, as well as common and sustainable institutional goals. The Technology Committee, chaired by BPS Information Technology (IT) Director, will meet as often as necessary to conduct its work, but typically at least quarterly.

TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES

Specific responsibilities of the Technology Committee include:

- Support the development of a BPS Technology Plan, based on the school's charter, its instructional goals, budget and facilities
- Identify and review instructional and operational technology needs and objectives, considering all populations served as well as infrastructure
- Identify issues, security and financial risks and opportunities to improve existing systems through investment and professional development
- Help establish and review pertinent technology protocols and systems, both internal and external (i.e.: purchasing, quoting, green school measures, etc.)
- Assist the IT Director in the creation of a tech plan and action steps (task force, deadline, resources) for each defined task in the tech plan, such as research, fundraising, trending, inventory, etc.
- Assist the IT Director in identifying important partnerships and vendors in the community that may help achieve BPS' tech plan goals
- Assist the IT Director in the development of the following schools years Annual Technology Budget for submittal to the HOS as a part of the Annual Budget
